On 08/27/2010, James Butler, a 50 year old male, presented with:

-- The patient is a 50 year old who reports a long history of schizophrenia. He has had ongoing psychotic symptoms including auditory hallucinations, paranoia, isolation, confusion, and disorganized thinking. He denies depression or mania. He has previously been treated at Mental Health and finds SEROQUEL works quite well, but has not had this in several months and notes the gradual recurrence of symptoms. He also reports a long history of cocaine, cannabis, and alcohol use, but has been clean and sober for over 3 months and is active in recovery.

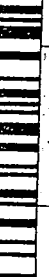

I was walking to my friend's house sometime maybe after 5 or right around 5:00 pm. Once I walked out the door of my house, I saw the old man that lives at 40 Robinson Ln. Pull up in a white and red pick up truck. As far as I know, this is his truck, and I have seen him driving it before. I saw him walk inside by himself. He had been inside for just a few minutes when I heard screaming like someone was hurt coming from inside the house. The screaming seemed like it lasted for like 5 or 6 minutes. Right after the screaming stopped, I saw a black male approximately 20-30 years old come out the back door of the house. The guy was wearing a black hoodie without the hoodie over his head, and I think he had on some dark blue jeans. When he first came out the back door, he wasn't running, he was just walking. He was rubbing his left hand on his pants leg like he was trying to get something off of it and had his other hand in his hoodie pocket. I then yelled for my friend because I was close to her house. When the guy heard me yell, he looked over at me, and then he started walking faster. The guy was heading towards the dirt road away from the old man's house. I didn't recognize this guy from being from around the neighborhood.

I've known James Davis for several years. I'm not sure how we first met, but he used to date my aunt. I then got to know him because he repairs cars, and I would have him work on mine sometimes.

My wife and I were at Sonic around 4:30 pm. After we left there, we stopped by McDonalds. I then decided to go by James' house to drop off an alternator bolt that he told me he needed to fix my Mitsubishi Galant. We got to James' house sometime close to 5:00. As I got to James' house, I noticed a white Cobalt in the yard across the street with a black male standing outside, staring at me. The male was in his early twenties, wearing a white hoodie over his head. As I pulled into James' driveway, the guy got into the Cobalt and left out in a hurry. I then walked up to James' house and knocked on the door. The door was closed, but when I knocked, it opened up. As it opened up, I saw James laying on the floor just far enough in front of the door where it wouldn't hit him. I walked up to him, and noticed his head was laying directly in vomit. I also saw a little bit of blood on his face, and on his clothes. The way everything looked, I was concerned that maybe someone had attacked him. I called his name several times, but he didn't answer. I did hear him breathing. I then walked to my car and called 911.

Earlier today I called James several times, but he didn't answer the phone. I thought this was strange because I wouldn't think he would go anywhere in this weather.
