

ORDER

Appellant has served and filed a notice of appeal from a circuit court order denying her appeal from the Fee Disputes Board of the South Carolina Bar. Appellant has also filed a petition for an order staying the distribution of the fee dispute award. After careful consideration, this appeal is dismissed because this court lacks jurisdiction to review this appeal. *See Wright v. Dickey*, 370 S.C. 517, 521, 636 S.E.2d 1, 3 (Ct. App. 2006) (dismissing appeal for lack of jurisdiction and holding "there is no appeal from a decision of the Resolution of Fee Disputes Board of the South Carolina Bar beyond the circuit court as set forth in Rule 416, SCACR, Rule 20."). Because this appeal is dismissed, Appellant's petition for an order of stay is denied. The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
