**MOTION FOR EXPEDITED RELIEF**

Movant notes that the Circuit Court has set his probate appeals without discussion on whether or not evidence can be taken by the Circuit Court on appeal as seen as Exhibit A.

**Additionally:**

- 1) Appellant has served multiple parties through the local sheriff of record of the original cause.
- 2) Appellant has provided additional evidence to the court directly via subpoenaed documents in the lower courts.
- 3) Mr. Gregory Parker admitted in front of former Chief Judge Hood in a hearing on March 15<sup>th</sup> 2019, that Probate Judge Smiley had hired him to represent the State of South Carolina in all Probate Actions at Palmetto Health, and that in fact he proceeded as the State Prosecutor in the case, and that no counsel of record was in fact present for Appellant who was NOT ALLOWED TO PRESENT ANY EVIDENCE IN THE PROBATE COURT, and presumed guilty of the charges without a trial.
- 4) Appellants Contracts in force with Bank of America and Verizon require them to defend him on all issues dealing with the company which are CROSS-CLAIMS to the original action presented by James R. Stritzinger.
- 5) Appellant still believes the lower court cause needs to be served as it was presented and set for trial rather than setting five individual proceedings as he motioned before. The original cause is:

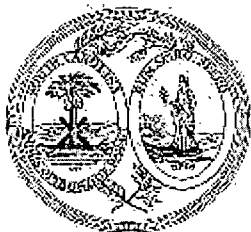


