**NOTICE OF FINAL JUDGEMENT BY FOREIGN COURT**

The State of Florida entered an appellate judgement terminating the criminal cause in the State of Florida, see US Supreme Court (Heath v Alabama - 474 U.S. 82). Appellant notes however that that case in his opinion was argued on the wrong grounds as Article IV of the Constitution requires that full faith and credit to each state be granted between each other, and instead the US Supreme Court only heard arguments about the sovereignty of each state to carry out their own laws. The issue is the same case on the same facts, has to have the cause tried under Article IV, thus the original dismissal in this case should have terminated it. Respondent believes Article IV is even stronger than the 5<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the US Constitution.

Respondent however was told by the State of Florida law enforcement teams both in Orlando and in the Florida State Police department that they didn't think he was correct and the action was still pending and they routinely wiretapped his home and used enhanced surveillance activities because of the cause started in this court which was a felony criminal investigation.


Effectively Ms. Darrell's action lead to his torture in two other states (FL, and VA) which he believes she is wholly responsible. Nevertheless, that cause is terminated by the Florida 5<sup>th</sup> Court of Appeals, and previously by the Florida Supreme Court which decided to not exercise its power of review.

My call for Ms. Darrell to be disbarred stands as respondent believes she sought out a police vigilante action following a preliminary hearing in this cause both in Virginia and in Florida if Office Hugel did not himself.

Movant notes that the FBI has wiretaps of Verizon Office buildings where they recorded Verizon calling the Maryland State Police using the tracking devices (GPS) on his corporate Verizon Cell Phone, and thus they not only filed a criminal complaint but also sought to physically harm him by participating in the police action.

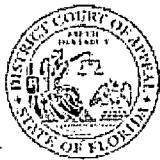
