
3.) Petitioner's claims are too complex and require lengthy research time to ensure his issues are properly before this court

3) I am indigent.


4) I am limited to one (1) day a week in the law library.

5) I have several claims that are too complex to articulate by a lay person within the time prescribed by this Court.


6) I suffer from a mental deficiency which impairs my ability to complete and submit a "Memorandum of Law" Brief in the



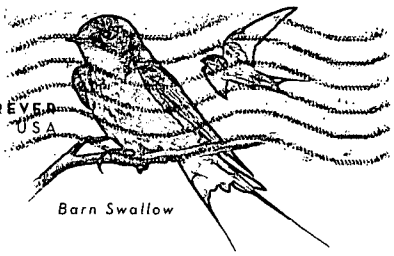

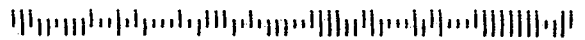
