MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY BRIEF

---

Appellants South Carolina Coastal Conservation League (“CCL”) and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy (“SACE) respectfully move this Court for an extension of time for Appellants to file their Initial Reply Brief. In support of this Motion, CCL and SACE state as follows:

1. South Carolina Electric and Gas Company will file an Initial Response Brief on April 3, 2019.
2. The Court granted requests by the South Carolina Solar Business Alliance, LLC and South Carolina Electric and Gas Company to extend their initial brief deadlines from February 1, 2019 to March 4, 2019 and from February 11, 2019 to April 3, 2019, respectively.
3. The current deadline for Initial Reply Briefs is April 15, 2019.
4. Due to changes in the previous deadlines, the Initial Reply Brief deadline now overlaps with planned family leave time for CCL and SACE’s counsel of record. CCL and SACE therefore respectfully request an extension of time of nine (9) days for Appellants to file their Initial Reply Brief.
5. This requested deadline extension is consistent with the parties’ Joint Motion for a Consolidated Briefing Schedule filed with the Court on January 29, 2019.
6. If the Court grants this request, Counsel for CCL and SACE calculate that the new deadline for filing will be Monday, April 22, 2019.
7. Counsel for CCL and SACE have consulted with counsel for South Carolina Electric and Gas Company, South Carolina Solar Business Alliance, LLC, Southern Current, LLC, South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff, and South Carolina Energy Users Committee, none of whom oppose this request. Counsel for CMC Steel South Carolina has advised that it takes no position on the motion.

Accordingly, CCL and SACE respectfully request that this Court grant this Motion and extend the time for Appellants to file their Initial Reply Brief until Monday, April 22, 2019.
