Dear Parkin:

As you know I have filed a Motion for an extension of time to file the Appellants' Brief and Designation of Matter to make it due 30 days after the latest decision of the Court on the Petition for Rehearing as to our Motion to Dismiss the appeal without prejudice or the Motion to Remand to complete the Record and stay the appeal pending that Remand.

I am forwarding a copy of this letter to the Court and would simply request that you advise the Court as to whether or not you have any objection to the extension being issued in this matter on that basis. I believe this would represent an economy of time for both the Court and the parties and would simply provide that the Brief and Designation would have to be filed within 30 days of the date that we know that it will have to be filed with the Court. 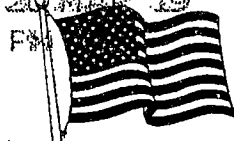
