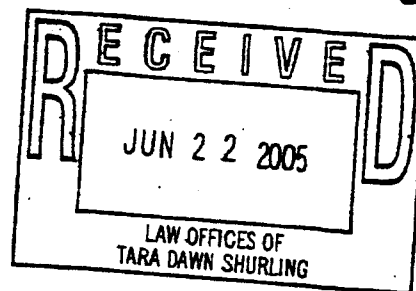

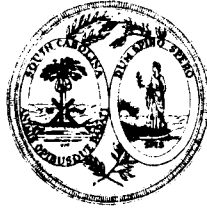

It is my duty to inform you that South Carolina law prohibits the Board of Probation, Parole, and Pardon Services from granting you parole on the sentence(s) identified below. Section 24-21-640 states: "[t]he board must not grant parole nor is parole authorized to any prisoner serving a sentence for a second or subsequent conviction, following a separate sentencing for prior conviction, for violent crimes as defined in Section 16-1-60." In order to file such an appeal, you must follow the instructions on the back of the enclosed "Notice of Appeal" form approved by the Administrative Law Court (ALC). You will also be required to comply with ALC Rules of Procedure for special appeals. Failure to follow the ALC instructions or Rules of Procedure will result in forfeiture of your right to challenge the Department's final decision.
