MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Matthew Ryan Brown respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until May 13, 2019**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Matthew Ryan Brown respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the


number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Edward Anthony v. State in the Supreme Court on February 1, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Clyde D. Singletary in the Court of Appeals on February 1, 2019. On January 30, 2019, Counsel had an oral argument in State v. Eric T. Spears before the Supreme Court. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Richard Burton Beekman v. State in the Supreme Court on January 28, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of Latisha Todd v. State in the Court of Appeals on January 16, 2019.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


