MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Casey Dajuan Geter respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days, until May 13, 2019**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. **Counsel will file the brief before this deadline if possible.** This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel four previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Casey Dajuan Geter respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Rickey Wilson with this Court on Wednesday, April 10, 2019. Counsel also filed a brief in the case of Samuel Gonzalez on Monday, April 8, 2019 with this Court. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Robert I. Graham before this Court on April 2, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Cory Nettles Allen before this Court on April 1, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Antwon Baker v. The State with the Supreme Court on March 26, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Aneisha Young with this Court on March 22, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Reginald Hamilton with this Court on March 4, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Tekysha Cohen before this Court on March 4, 2019. Counsel presented at the “Year End” CLE in Greenville, South Carolina on February 8, 2019. **Counsel has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender, including administrative and Appellate Project oversight, and training three less experienced appellate defenders and reviewing all their filings in advance.**

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General’s office consents to this request shown by signature below.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned counsel would respectfully request a **final thirty (30) day extension until May 13, 2019**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case based upon the above exigent circumstances. **Counsel will file the brief before this deadline if possible.** Counsel requests that time limits for filing the brief be held in abeyance pending a ruling on this motion.
