PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI  
AND ACCOMPANYING APPENDIX

Counsel for Shazjuan S. Shabazz petitions the Court for a **final thirty day extension, until March 1, 2013** in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case. In support of this petition, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. This is the fourth extension for Mr. Shabazz. **Counsel acknowledges that a fourth extension request for a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix is in contradiction to the rules of the Court, however, counsel had to testify in a PCR hearing in Lexington, SC today, January 30, 2013. Counsel will attempt to have this petition completed and filed by February 15, 2013.**

2. Counsel for Mr. Shabazz respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time.


3. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Anthony Rodrickus Carter and the Brief of Appellant Pursuant to White v. State in State v. Ronald Black on January 28, 2013. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in State v. Frederick R. Chappell on January 25, 2013. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Darryl Frierson v. State on January 10, 2013. On January 7, 2013, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Cesar Portillo. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Wesley Smith, the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of State v. Doyle Marion Garrett (in the COA), and the Return to the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Antonio D. Bordeaux v. State all in the Supreme Court on December 27, 2012. Additionally, Counsel filed the petitions for rehearing in the cases of State v. Larry Bradley Brayboy and State v. Marion Stewart in the Court of Appeals on December 27, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of State v. Travis Teasley (in the COA) in the Supreme Court, as well as the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. John Wayne Brannon in the Court of Appeals, on December 21, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Sylvester Davis v. State in the Supreme Court on December 19, 2012. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in State v. Demetrius Price on December 17, 2012. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Roman Millen was filed on December 13, 2012. Counsel filed the return to petition for

writ of certiorari in State v. Daniel Jenkins on December 7, 2012. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in State v. Frankie McGee and had an oral argument in State v. Timothy Wallace on December 5, 2012.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purposes of delay.

Counsel respectfully requests **a final thirty day extension, until March 1, 2013**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case based upon the above circumstances. However as stated above counsel will make every attempt to have this petition filed by **February 15, 2013**.




