Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I was appointed to represent Mr. White in connection with indictment numbers 2018-GS-06-00200 (murder) and 2018-GS-06-00201 (armed robbery). On October 17, 2018, Defendant was convicted and sentenced to forty (40) years and thirty (30) years, respectively. On October 25, 2018, Defendant filed a timely post-trial motion for a New Trial based on insufficient evidence and a motion to Reconsider Sentence.

Since Judge Early had already retired before ruling on the post-trial motions and out of an abundance of caution, I filed a Notice of Intent to Appeal (Appellate Case No.: 2019-000403). A Special Order was entered allowing Judge Early to decide the post-trial motions. On April 12, 2019, Judge Early denied Defendant's motions.

I am seeking the Court's guidance on whether I need to file a new Notice of Intent to Appeal now that the post-trial motions have been ruled on or if the original Notice of Intent, which has already been filed, will suffice.

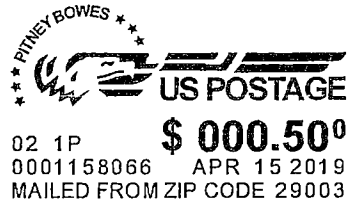
