Motion for Reconsideration

The Appellant 2019-000473 hereby files a motion of Reconsideration for the two indictment listed above. The appellant hereby requests the courts to bless him with 15 years to run concurrent on both sentences. So that with rehabilitation he may see society again and become a productive citizen.

Reason for reconsideration:
