
ORDER

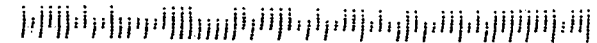
