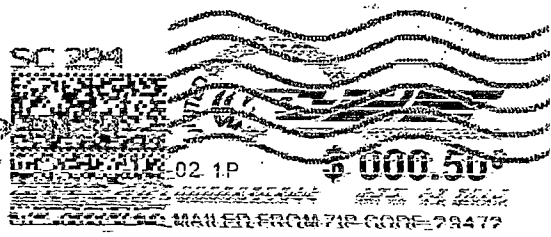
Appellant asks that the procedures in Anders v. California be applicable to Appellant, and ask that the SC Court of Appeals establish record of request and respond.
