Please allow this letter to confirm our telephone conversation this afternoon regarding the status of the Appellant's transcript order in the above-referenced matter, which is now pending on appeal. Our law firm represents the Appellant, Bi-Lo, LLC. As you will recall, on behalf of the Appellant, we ordered transcripts from two (2) proceedings related to the instant appeal, both of which took place in Dorchester County before the Honorable DeAndrea G. Benjamin and were transcribed by court reporter Harry A. Walker. The first proceeding was a trial held on April 23 and 24, 2012. The second was a hearing on post-trial motions held on June 27, 2012.

As I discussed with you on the telephone today, I received a telephone call from Ms. Walker yesterday wherein Ms. Walker kindly advised that she had the requested transcripts in line for preparing but, for a number of reasons, she needed additional time to provide the transcripts and that she would be making a request for such an extension in the near future.
