On January 9, 2019 I got found guilty of Burglary 1st degree. I was sentenced to life in prison. Paul K. Neely represented me on this case. He made many mistakes doing trial. I was found not guilty of Assault and Battery 1st degree and Strong Arm Robbery. S.C. Code 16-11-311 states that in order for this to be a Burglary 1st, 2nd, or 3rd the state had to prove my intent to commit a crime. It is my understanding that because the jury found me not guilty of all other crimes in this case, The state fail to prove my intent to commit a crime. Therefore the Burglary 1st conviction should have been nullified. Among his many mistakes and oversights he fail to raise this issue. What options other than the appeal process do I have in this circumstance? Can't this case be brought back in front of the original judge due to this oversight? I greatly appreciate any help you may be able to provide in this situation.

This was what I wrote to the Head Public Defender's Office. His name is Clay Allen. I never got a response from him either. It was written to him February 28, 2019.

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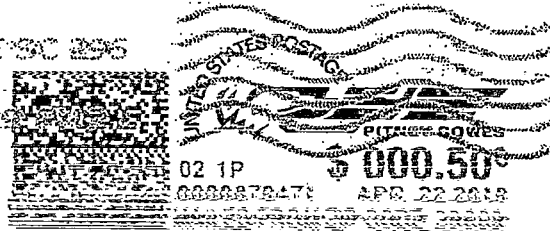

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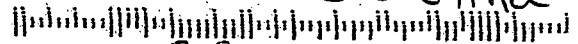
