For the last (12) Months, due to the April 2017 Riot here at Lee Correctional, the dorm in which I have been forced to reside has been on extensive Lockdown. This has consisted of 24-hours-a-day confinement to our cells, a shower maybe once-a-week, little phone access, and sparse access to the Law and even mail. *Within this time-frame*, my appellate defender filed a Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and my time to file a *pro se* brief expired.

On Monday the 15th of April, we finally were released from Lockdown status after 365 days. Given the above forced inability to properly file a *pro se* brief, I pray that this Honorable Court consider these extraordinary circumstances and grant me (60) days to research, compose, and file my issues. Preservation of these issues is critical to my appellate case.

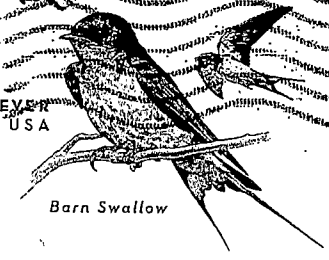
