ORDER

Because Appellant failed to provide proof he timely served the Administrative Law Court with the notice of appeal, this appeal is dismissed. *See* Rule 203(b)(6), SCACR ("When a statute allows a decision of the administrative law court or agency (administrative tribunal) to be appealed directly to the Supreme Court or the Court of Appeals, the notice of appeal shall be served on the agency, the administrative law court (if it has been involved in the case) and all parties of record within thirty (30) days after receipt of the decision.").¹ The remittitur will be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
