



INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on JAN 23 2019, the Grand Jurors of Spartanburg County present upon their oath:

CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT - THIRD DEGREE

That Christopher L. Pilgrim did, in Spartanburg County on or about September 8, 2018, engage in sexual battery upon the victim, Annie White, and such sexual battery was accomplished by the use of force or coercion to accomplish the battery in the absence of aggravating circumstances and/or the defendant had reason to know that the victim is mentally defective, mentally incapacitated, or physically helpless, and aggravated force or aggravated coercion was not used to accomplish the sexual battery, all in violation of §16-3-654, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, (1976), as amended.

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
