Dear Judge Beatty,

I, Marva Sanders is writing to you in regards of my son, Keyln Jarmand Cohen, an Inmate at Spartanburg County Detention Center in Spartanburg, SC. On July 10/2018 he was arrested on Hwy 101, by **Rodney A. Chambers**. Mr. Chambers at the time of the arrest stated on the report that Keyln was moving around as if he was nervous and he ask him why. Kelyn was moving around because he was standing in front of the hood and the lights in which was hot at the time and suffered a 3rd degree burn. He had him on the scene over 8 to 10 minutes after he ran his name in and saw that he had a charge that was also an **illegal search** by the Greer Police in June by, **Officer Corporal J. Compton**, doing the Alpha Shift. Compton saw a rented Vehicle in My yard, where my son Keyln had fallen asleep in and left the lights on. Compton claim he was looking a stolen vehicle in the area, but he failed to look up the tag number to the car that was a rental from Enterprise Car Rental in Greer, SC. The reason I am writing to is that my Son, Keyln was not **TREATED** for his burn at the Greer Police Department, he was there until they transported him to Greenville, then Spartanburg Detention Center, then treated. The burn had become infected and did not heal for about 1 month. He filed a 1983, in which he has been **DENIED** by **Judge Jaquelyn D. Austin** at 300 E. Washington Street, suite 239, Greenville, SC 29601. She sent him a denial letter claiming that there is **no officer** by the name of **Rodney A. Chambers** on the police force in Greer and his name is stated on all the papers of Keylns' arrest. It seems as though they do not want to take responsibility of him getting injured, also I am not condoning my son of drug use but The Greer police force really like to Profile people, but they do it in an unlawful way, it is just also when he paid to be on house arrest, they came out to my house, on 9/23/2018 and arrested him for violation and he had already been in jail for the first charge, they claim the drugs

was late being tested. He was already on house arrest, he is still incarcerated. This judicial system is really messed of how they operated things, as I said I will never condone drugs and I know my son has been arrest in the past, but his **Lawyer Richard Warder**, has shown me how they violated his 4th Amendment Rights, by coming in my yard bamming on the car window and my son was asleep in the car. There proof of Mr. Chamber is the envelope that he is employed at Greer Police Department. I was given advice from Ms. Brenda Benson to Contact you about this matter, I would really appreciate if this matter is looked into, because it is happening a lot in Spartanburg and Greenville County Law Enforcement.
