RECONSTRUCTION OF
EVIDENTIARY HEARING TRANSCRIPT

This matter comes before the Court pursuant to an Order issued by the South Carolina Supreme Court dated April 17, 2018. By way of said Order, Applicant's appeal was held in abeyance and the matter was remanded to the Honorable Robert E. Hood "to hold a hearing to determine if the portions of the recording of the evidentiary hearing deemed inaudible by the transcribing court reporter can be discerned and agreed upon by the parties, and if not, for reconstruction of the record of petitioner's testimony."

After obtaining the recording from February 27, 2017, a hearing was conducted at the Richland County Courthouse on July 23, 2018. Applicant was present and was represented by Tricia A. Blanchette, Esquire. Respondent was represented by Christian Saville, Assistant Attorney General.

As a result of listening to the recording at that hearing, this Court issued an Order finding that it was necessary to order another certified court reporter to transcribe the evidentiary hearing transcript from the audio recording. Upon completion, the transcript was to be provided to both parties, along with a copy of the audio recording. Each party was ordered to review the transcript for accuracy and inform this Court of their conclusions.

Thereafter, a transcript was completed by Pamela Green, Circuit Court Reporter, and this Court ensured that both parties received the transcript and the audio recording to

review. Upon both parties review, written correspondence was sent to Ms. Green regarding counsels' review of the audio transcription and objections / clarifications. Subsequently, the transcript was revised twice and received by counsel on or about February 22, 2019. On that same date, counsel notified this Court by letter and asked for further guidance. After conducting a phone conference, this Court has concluded that both parties are satisfied with the final revision of the transcript and no further action and/or reconstruction is needed. Therefore, this Court finds that purpose of the remand has been met and the matter shall be sent back to the South Carolina Supreme Court.


