

## ORDER

After dismissing the appeal in this matter, the South Carolina Court of Appeals denied petitioner's motion for reinstatement or rehearing on September 11, 2012. When no petition for a writ of certiorari was filed within the time specified by Rule 242, SCACR, the Court of Appeals properly sent the remittitur on October 25, 2012. Rule 221, SCACR.

Petitioner has now filed a document entitled "Petition for Rehearing" in which he seeks review of the decision of the Court of Appeals.<sup>1</sup> Since the remittitur has been properly sent, appellate jurisdiction over this case has ended. Accordingly, the document filed with this Court is dismissed. *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d 551 (2007).
