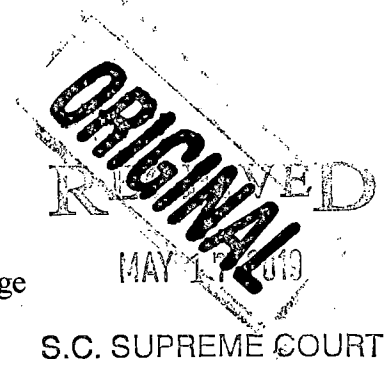

MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Felicia N. Cooper respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until June 17, 2019**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Felicia N. Cooper respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Abel Dewayne Gause on April 19, 2019. Counsel filed the amended initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Orin Jerrell Kemp with the Court of Appeals on April 12, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Wesley Charles Malmister with the Court of Appeals on April 3, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Julie L. Gordon-Gookins v. The State with this Court on April 3, 2019. Counsel had oral argument before the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Michael Jay Finley on April 2, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Michael K. Peterson v. The State with this Court on March 22, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Darrell Griffin v. The State with this Court on March 18, 2019. Counsel had oral argument in the case of The State v. Roy Ellis Smith before the Court of Appeals on March 14, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




