

On March 20, 2019, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. David Allen Tindal, Jr. with the Court of Appeals. On March 8, 2019, counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in The State v. Reginald Rodezere Scurry with the Court of Appeals. 
4. As indicated by the consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


