On May 7, 2019 your office wrote to me concerning several deficiencies with my filings. I was given 60 days to correct them from the date the letter was written. However, as I explained previously, I am housed in one of the most restrictive living areas at this prison and presently the prison and all level-3 prisons are on lock down. Therefore, I am unable to correct the deficiencies at this time. Also, your letter is dated May 7, 2019, but I did not receive it

until May 13, 2019 (6) days later,
and because of the lock down, I can
not copy the documents needed to
correct the deficiencies to mail to the
Court and the Respondents.

I don't know the case of Ward, but
I do know that our High Court has
ruled that I must be given a chance
to correct issues with the appeal
before it is dismissed. I don't believe
at this time that I have made a
chance to do so under my current
circumstances.

Please extend my time to fix my appeal
10-days after the institution lock down
ends.

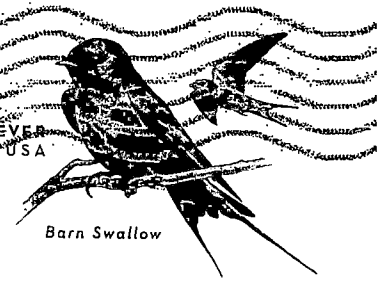
