Dear Mr. Washington:

I have reviewed the transcript that you received from Melissa Singletary, a South Carolina Judicial Branch court reporter, regarding the above referenced proceedings.

I am writing to let you know what I have found in reviewing the transcript you dispute. My findings are numbered in accordance with your letter to me, dated April 22, 2019.

1. Court Reporters do not start capturing the record until the case is called by the presiding Judge. Therefore, any conversations taking place in the courtroom before your case was called, would not have been captured on the record.
2. Based on my review of the audio and the transcript, overall I determined that the transcript contained a verbatim accounting of what was said in court.
3. Upon listening to the audio of the hearing, the date that was actually stated in court was "1980" and not "2015" as alleged in your letter. No error found.

4. Page 9, line 24, should have read "venue" as opposed to "a new". Error found and corrected.

As I listened to the audio, there was not a point in which I could hear the audience answer about what you were saying, as you have stated in your letter to me. The statement you allege to have said, "I stated based on your rulings are bias, prejudice and unfair toward me and denying me my constitutional right to due process of law, you honor." is not on the audio and therefore, would not be included in the transcript. No error found.

As to the challenge of page 12, line 25 and page 13, lines 1-5 the transcript reads exactly as it is stated on the audio. No error found.

In response to your challenge of page 9, line 24 and page 10, line 10, the transcript reads exactly as it is stated on the audio. No error found.

5. In response to your challenge of page 8, lines 7-10, the transcript reads exactly as it is clearly stated on the audio. There is a portion of the audio where the speaker is not clear, so we cannot confirm or deny that a change would be required.

In response to your challenge of page 3, line 1 and page 8, line 6, the transcript reads exactly as stated on the audio. It is denied that the audio states anything else if alleged in your letter.

6. In response to your challenge of page 10, line 8-10, the transcript reads exactly as it is stated on the audio. It is denied that the audio states anything else as alleged in your letter. No error found.

You are correct in your statement that on page 10, line 11-14, wherein you say, "I am trying to get a hearing on my rule 60 motions to vacate Judge Dennis orders based on fraud on the court, by the attorneys, the Trident Medical Center attorneys." The additional clause, "which denied me a full and fair opportunity to be heard", as stated in your letter, was not found on the audio. No error found.

7. In response to your challenge of page 11, line 19, the transcript reads exactly as it is stated on the audio. No error found.

8. In response to your challenge of page 12, line 8-16, the transcript reads (difficult to understand), I did however, hear you say "ex parte Carter..." which has now been added in the amended transcript. Everything else in this section of the transcript reads exactly as it is stated on the audio. It is denied that the audio states anything else if alleged in your letter.

9. In response to your challenge of page 12, line 20 and page 13, line 5, the transcript reads exactly as it is stated on the audio. No error found.

I hope this clears any discrepancies up that you may have or had about the above referenced transcript.
