In regards to the courts inquiry on this case, the orders I am complaining of on appeal are as follows:

- a) Judge Hood(Chief Judge of the 5th Circuit), and Judge Birch(Chief Judge of the 4th Circuit) entered a partial order on a Motion to Continue and Other relief on September 15th in Oral Form, and in written form on 9/20/2018.
- b) Judge Kelly entered an order dismissing the case on 11/29/2019.
- c) Judge Manning entered an order denying the consolidation of three cross claims with the original appeal on Petition for Writ of Certiorari, and ordered me to segment the case on 1/8/2019.
- d) Judge Kelly entered a final order of dismissal on 2/20/2019.


All of these orders are included on the original appeal which would have been timely from 2/20/2019 for 30 days. My appeal was filed in a timely manner as the court has already ruled.


Since this time, the court has denied individual relief in the related cases of 2018CP4006288 and 2018CP4006289 both of which were effectively consolidated in the original filing, and both which have been denied individually and are included in my briefs.

The Florida Court of Appeals recently found me insolvent, and took a related appeal on issues with Verizon without fees being assessed as included with their order as attached.

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, by the Courts as follows:

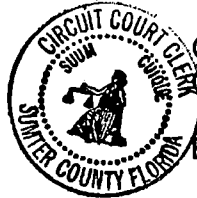
The Plaintiff be, and he is hereby declared to be indigent with the meaning of Florida Rules of Civil Procedure.
