Attached is the Supplement to the Respondents' submitted Record on Appeal as well as the Amended filings already submitted to the Respondents and the Court, the last submission was on or about February 12, 2019, at the time she responded to the Motion to Strike with the updates. To require Appellant to provide the Respondents an entire new Record on Appeal would be a hardship on her. The copies required in the May 19, 2019, Order is a hardship but Appellant has located funds to provide these five copies for the Court.


IN CONCLUSION

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
