

Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of John Cleveland Jr. v. State in the Supreme Court on March 27, 2019. Counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of State v. Carmine James Miranda, III in the Supreme Court on March 22, 2019.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


4. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


