MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

RETURN TO PETITION FOR WRIT OF
CERTIORARI

Counsel for Allen Stone respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until June 24, 2019**, in which to file the return to petition for writ of certiorari in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The return to petition for writ of certiorari is due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Allen Stone respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Darrell Ervin Raines, Jr. before the Court of Appeals on April 2, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Thomas Smith with the Court of Appeals on April 1, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Vladimir W. Pantovich v. The State before the Supreme Court on March 27, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Gerald R. Williams before the Supreme Court on March 26, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Robin Renee Herndon with this Court on March 21, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




