MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Jeffrey Darrell Cromer respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until June 28, 2019**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Jeffrey Darrell Cromer respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In The Matter of the Care and Treatment of Otis Alford with the Court of Appeals on April 16, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. William Heath with the Court of Appeals on April 5, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Darrell Ervin Raines, Jr. before the Court of Appeals on April 2, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Thomas Smith with the Court of Appeals on April 1, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of Vladimir W. Pantovich v. The State before this Court on March 27, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


