Below is a copy of a letter mailed 8 May 2019. As of today, I have not receive any rulings on anything at all.

Please ensure you enter orders, of course only as you see fit and proper, ASAP next week. I especially am interested, as I'm sure you are very aware, in having case 2014-CP-10-05407 remanded to the lower court NO LATER THAN 21 May 2019.

If you look at the SC Clerk of Court manual and how to manage Rule 40(j) restores, etc., you will see how separating it from the case you tried to join it with is improper. This bizarre situation has only occurred because Judge Scarborough knowingly and intentionally chose to do the wrong thing and restore it to the Active docket on 9 May 2017, instead of following the proper practice..... and then had to dispose of it on 13 Nov 2017. And clearly, despite Judge Scarborough's assertions, logically case 2014-CP-10-05407 can't be the same case as a case labeled 2017-CP-10-04031.
