Dear Ms. Woods,

This is in response to your May 25, 2019 email requesting approval from Respondents, Roosevelt Rollins and Sharon Miller Young, to move forward with your Appeal *without* satisfying the SCACR Rule 207 transcript requirements. You served your Notice of Appeal on or about August 23, 2018, and Rule 207 requires that you order a transcript within 10 days thereafter and that you deliver a copy of the transcript(s) within 60 days from that date which, by my calculation, would have been approximately November 3, 2018.

Please be advised that neither of my clients, who are the Respondents in this Appeal, will consent to any waiver of the requirements of SCACR Rule 207. Respondents will require strict compliance with Rule 207. To agree otherwise would not allow the Court of Appeals to have a full record of the matters on appeal and would be unfair to Judge Dukes, who presided over the hearings for which you are required to supply transcripts.

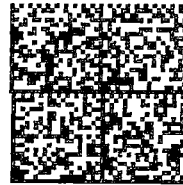
