Please take this into consideration.

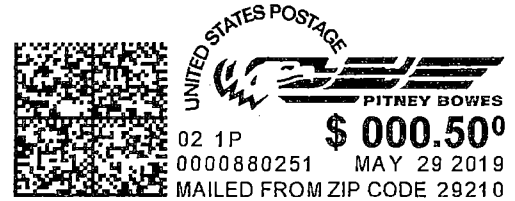
