MEMORANDUM RECORD ON APPEAL

Appellants response to letter received 05/ 29/19from the Clerk of Appeals Court Dated 05/17/19.

Comes now Appellants to inform the Clerk and Court that the Courts decision to reinstate the appeal is appreciated in light of seeking justice.

However, appellants filed to proceed in Forma Pauperis , filed Feb 20, 2019 stating their financial position.

The Law does not allow impossibilities. Max.

Pursuant to Appellant Rules, your letter stating appellants "must provide proof that the entire transcript has been ordered within ten (10) days of the date of this order." The order, for appellants , creates an impossibility.

For the appellants to provide "proof they ordered the entire transcript" appellants would have to pay for the full cost of the transcript estimated to be \$1215.00, possibly higher after actual transcription, to be paid in full, when ordering the transcript. An impossibility for the appellants, as appellants currently do not have \$1215.00 to pay for and order the entire transcript, before the Court will proceed to decide on the state of the appeal process.

The Rule and Order creates and imposes a financial hardship on appellants, and is in effect an abrogation of the right to due process, by preventing the forward movement of the appeal process, for the sake of profit, to an outsourced provider, at cost to the appellants, not a cost to the party who brought the original action to the courts.


Appellants did not bring this action before the Courts of South Carolina. Appellants are seeking Justice from the decisions of the lower courts failing to follow the Law, the Code, the Statutes and the Rules of the Courts of South Carolina.

As stated in Appellants MOTION IN FORMA PAUPERIS, Appellants receive \$660.00 per month from Social Security and does not have other funds , other than seeking donations from the local community who appellants do not know, only being in the community for roughly 1 year.

Therefore the appellants would ask this Court to provide a remedy that would allow the Appeal Process to move forward in a manner that does not prejudice the appellants in this matter.


