Over the pass months of February and March I've been coming up with more New information about my case. I just got ² today's (well or Feb. 2, 2019) that my mother had wrote down the dates of ~~has~~ ^{who} and when she talked to Sheriff's Office and Solicitor about the Ford F-350 which was hers.

Info:

- 1) She called Court Clerk's office in July after the 11th and talk to Clerk Jessica who instructed her to call Deputy Al Cannon. Which she did at #864-895-0178 (message)
- 2) The next time she talked to a Supervisor Sgt. Scott Matheny A-4 ^{and} ~~was~~ was told that she could come and get her belongings out of the truck, because the truck was being used as evidence and she would have to wait until court to get her truck back.
- 3) 8-21-17 at 10:48 she called and left a message that she wanted to come get the belongings out of the truck, no one called her back.
- 4) 10-27-17 She spoke to Sgt. Scott Matheny A-4 then he told her she would not be able to get the truck back "this is when she found out about Solicitor Howard Steinburg".
- 5) On 11-12-17 she sent Solicitor the copy of the title he asked her to provide for him that showed the name of the owner / ownership of the truck.
- 6) She called attorney ~~s~~ on 11-28-17 to see if a court date for the truck was available "she left message with Carrie Cotton at time of 10:12 am".

Next there has arised in Supreme Court on Feb. 20, 2019 by Justice Ginsburg, but also Justices Thomas and Neil M. Gorsuch agreed with the outcome. Both relied on the 14th amendment, Justice Thomas even wrote this that this system where police can seize property with limited judicial oversight

and retain it for their own use " which my little Brother was on his way back to GA. about a month ago and was pretty sure that he seen the police/sheriff using the truck on I-85 north" - has led to egregious and well-chronicled abuse. That chronicled how aggressive policing tactics resulted in million of dollars taken from motorists not charged with crimes. See I was a victim of this aggressive policing tactics. Reason I said this is because in Deputy Sheriff Al Cannon report he says he was advise tha the truck was paid " although he ~~from~~ forgot to mention that he asked me this question in order to hide his interrogation tactics he uses/used and before he mention he was going to / want to seize the truck he says " being that he was advise the truck was paid for that he decided to seize along with the trafficking charge as the second part of his decision ". So, first since the truck was paid for is when he really decided because with out it he would not have tried to seize the truck at all. Well this I've been informed of lately.
