MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel for Gartharee Hinson respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the return to petition for writ of certiorari in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The return to petition for writ of certiorari are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Gartharee Hinson respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. 

John Arthur James, III, with the Court of Appeals on April 29, 2019. Counsel had oral argument in the case of The State v. Shawn Allen Mitchell before the Court of Appeals on April 2, 2019. Counsel had oral argument before this Court in the case of The State v. Demario M. Thompson on March 28, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.


