WITNESS WHO WAS THERE THAT NIGHT WHEN
THE INCIDENT HAPPEN CANNOT DO NO
INCOURT IDENTIFICATION ON FRANKIE MCGEE
NEITHER CAN SHE POSITIVELY ID HIM IN
COURT BECAUSE SHE HAS ALREADY

(1) FRANKIE MCGEE D.M.A. WAS NOT AT THE
VICTIM RESIDENCE INSIDE NEITHER OUTSIDE
NEITHER ON VICTIM PROPERTY.

(2) FRANKIE MCGEE D.M.A. WAS NOT ON THE
METAL BAR THAT WAS USED IN THE CRIME.

(3) FRANKIE MCGEE WAS NOT PRESENT AT THE
VICTIM RESIDENCE WHEN INCIDENT HAPPEN
ON (MAY-3-09) AT 11:45 PM AND NO ONE
NEVER IDENTIFIED MCGEE AS BEING PRESENT
THAT NIGHT.

(4) DURING TRIAL THE WITNESS WHO WAS THERE
WHEN THE INCIDENT HAPPEN AT THE VICTIM

(6) DURING TRIAL ON (8-1-11) A COLUMBIA CITY POLICE DEPT UNIFORM OFFICER TESTIFIED ON STAND TO SAY WHILE ENROUTE TO THE CRIMESCENE THE DISPATCH DESCRIPTION OF SUSPECT WAS BLUE JEANS WHITE T-SHIRT HE TESTIFIED TO SAY HE SAW (TWO) SUBJECTS WALKING BUT THE ONE MATCHING THE DESCRIPTION FLED ON FEET HE CHASED HIM 1/2-MILE TO HIS RESIDENCE THEY FOUND HIM HIDING IN A CLOSET HIS NAME IS (DAVID WILLIAM) HE WAS ARRESTED AND POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED BY THE WITNESS (TEMIEKA ASHFORD) AS THE SUSPECT STANDING IN THE VICTIM YARD. 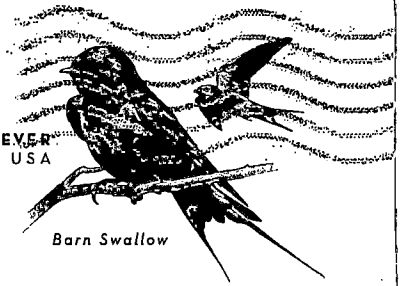
