I am in receipt of your Transcript Request Form ordering the transcript of the above hearing. This hearing was recorded using the state's digital recording system and the files have been forwarded to me for transcription by Desiree Allen with Court Administration. I have reviewed the file, and based on the length of the hearing, I estimate that the transcript will be approximately 35 pages.

Rule 607 provides that the rate of \$4.25 shall be charged per page for a transcript. Based on the current rate, the estimated cost will be \$148.75 plus \$2.20 postage for a total of \$150.95. Upon receipt of your cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$150.95, I will be able to place your request in line for production. If the transcript is less than 35 pages, I will refund the difference to you upon delivery of the transcript. If the transcript is more than 35 pages, the balance will be due prior to delivery of the transcript. Please make check payable to Cheryl Smith and mail to me at PO Box 80032, Simpsonville, SC 29680.

Under our rules, I have sixty days in which to complete the transcript after receipt of the deposit. In addition, I am allowed to request from Court Administration thirty-day extensions, if necessary, to complete the transcript. You will be notified if extensions are granted.

You have indicated on the Transcript Request Form that you want the transcript expedited. Rule 607 provides that the rate of \$5.00 shall be charged per page for a transcript. At this rate, the estimated cost of the transcript will be \$177.20 including postage. If you are still wanting the transcript expedited, please remit this amount to the address above. The turnaround time for expedited transcripts is seven days.

If you desire to cancel the request for the transcript, a cancellation request must be made in writing. You will be responsible for payment of any portion of the transcript that has been completed.
