Upon reviewing your record on appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The record on appeal does not comply with Rule 267(d), SCACR. Pursuant to Rule 267(d), SCACR, the record on appeal must be bound in volumes not exceeding 250 sheets each. The record on appeal submitted contains approximately 1000 pages/500 sheets. It is not accepted as filed.
- Each volume of the record on appeal must be bound and include the title page, consisting of the same heavyweight paper as used on the 1<sup>st</sup> volume.
- Each volume must contain an index.
- The certificate of counsel has not been signed as required by Rule 267(b), SCACR.
