

On April 8, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Wade Rouse v. The State with the Supreme Court. On April 2, 2019, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Anthony M. Enriquez before the Court of Appeals. On March 27, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Michael A. Manigan v. The State with the Supreme Court. On March 22, 2019, counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in The State v. Stanley Anthony Dimitroff, II with the Court of Appeals.


