Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Christopher D. Campbell with this Court on May 9, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in Conway in the case of State v. Steven Otts with this Court on April 17, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Jamie Lee Simpson with the Court of Appeals on April 9, 2019.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


4. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


