
PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF FILING DATE FOR INITIAL BRIEF

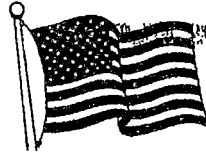
