As the record will reflect, this law firm represents Respondent Roosevelt Rawlins, Trustee of the William Bligen Trust ("Respondent Rawlins") and Respondent Sharon Miller Young, ("Respondent Young") in the above-referenced appellate proceeding.

Appellant initiated this appeal by filing of Notice of Appeal dated August 23, 2018. Our records reflect that the transcript(s) were ordered by Appellant on September 7, 2018, and that Appellant Woods failed to comply with Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR, both initially and as a result of various extensions and delays imposed at Appellant's request.

More recently, Appellant requested that she be allowed to proceed without a transcript, and you responded to Ms. Woods by letter dated May 16, 2019 (copy attached) informing her that, unless all parties agreed in writing *not* to require compliance with the transcript requirements, she must comply with Rule 207 by May 26, 2019. In my letter of May 27, 2019 (copy attached), I advised the Court of Appeals that I did *not* consent to Appellant proceeding without satisfying the transcript requirements of Rule 207.

It is now 11 days after May 26, 2019 and, to my knowledge, Appellant has not satisfied the requirements set forth in your May 16, 2019 correspondence.

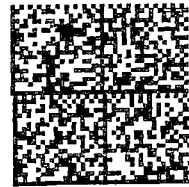
