Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your Notice of Appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected in its entirety within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will not be considered:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, this case is being appealed from the Court of Common Pleas.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- According to Rule 203, SCACR, a notice of appeal must include the name of the court from which the appeal is taken; the judge's name; the lower court docket number; the date of the order being appealed; a statement of when the appealing party received the decision from which the appeal is taken; the name of the appealing party; and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.

- An amended notice of appeal must be filed which deletes all assertions of error by the trial court. These matters are not appropriate in a notice of appeal.
