Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your letter ordering the transcript from court administration, the following deficiency has been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- Pursuant to Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR, you must order the transcript and make an agreement regarding payment for the transcript in writing with the court reporter. The letter provided as the letter ordering the transcript is not addressed to the court reporter but to court administration.

- In order to be in compliance with Rule 207(a)(1), SCACR, appellant shall contemporaneously furnish all parties, the Office of Court Administration, and the clerk of the appellate court with copies of all correspondence with the court reporter. The court reporter must acknowledge receipt of the request by responding to the appellant within five business days. Where required by paragraph (a)(7) and by Order of the Supreme Court, copies of all correspondence must also be provided by electronic means.
