

This is to acknowledge that on June 11, 2019, I received your email/letter dated June 11, 2019 requesting the Transcript of Record in the above matter. I have reviewed my files and the record indicates that this hearing lasted approximately a half hour. I estimate the number of pages will be (25) twenty-five.

Pursuant to Article V, Section 4 of the South Carolina Constitution, Rule 607(h)(1) provides that the rate of \$4.25 shall be charged per page for a transcript and \$1.00 for a previously prepared transcript. The estimated cost for the transcript could/will be **\$106.25**. An Invoice with the final cost will be provided requesting payment before the transcript will be delivered.

Under our rules, I have sixty days in which to complete the transcript. In addition, I am allowed to request from Court Administration thirty days extensions, if necessary, to complete the transcript. You will be notified if extensions are granted.
