- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, it should read as follows on the appellants final brief:

Tymika Jones Alston and Harold Alston individually And as Parents and Guardians on behalf of their minor child, J.A., Appellants,

v.

Donald Richard Torres d/b/a DMT Construction Co., Inc., L&L Electric, Inc. and Eduardo Moreno d/b/a E.S. Moreno Construction, Defendants,

Of which Donald Richard Torres d/b/a DMT Construction Co., Inc., is the Respondent.

- The initial brief is not accompanied by a designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.
- Rule 209, SCACR, requires that the documents you wish the Court to review be listed in the designation of matter. Accordingly, your material labeled as "exhibits" that was filed with the appellants initial brief is being returned to you.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
