Please advise if you require additional information. Trusting this is satisfactory, I remain

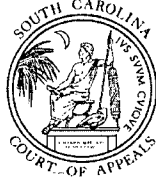

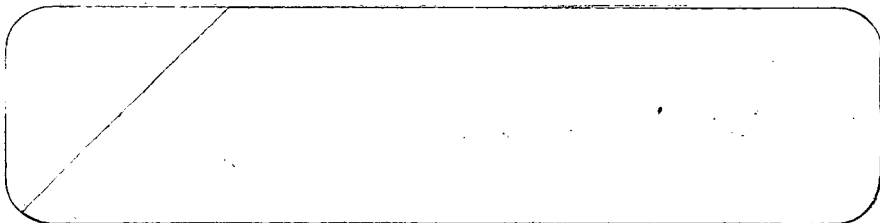
